



CHARITY FARM DEVELOPMENT UPDATE

The Trustees thought you would like an update of progress on the proposed Charity Farm Housing Development.

The Trustees have applied for Outline Planning Permission for 25 Dwellings on the 2.4 acre Charity Farm Site in Middle Street.

The 25 Dwellings include 15 Houses, which will be for sale on the Open Market, and the provision 10 Affordable Dwellings for rent. This is in accordance with the Ashcott Neighbourhood Plan which received approximately 85% approval in a Village Referendum in 2016.

The 10 Affordable Dwellings will satisfy the requirements of Sedgemoor District Council's "Housing Needs Survey", which was conducted in the Village at the end of last year and published in January 2019.

The Trustees await Sedgemoor District Council's decision on our Application.

VILLAGE SURVEY - NOT ENDORSED BY PARISH OR DISTRICT COUNCIL

It has come to the attention of the Parish Council that there is an individual who is conducting a 'Parish Survey'. Please note that this is not supported by the Parish Council or the District Council. A draft of the survey came to the attention of the Parish Council and it contained political questions on the reverse whilst being presented with colours similar to that of the Liberal Democratic Party. The Parish Council is strictly non-political. Do not answer any questions you are uncomfortable with or do not complete the survey if you are uncomfortable with the purpose to which it is being used. Please do remember that your vote is always private and you do not need to disclose how you voted in any election to anyone, in any form, verbal, written, or on survey. The Parish Council are unsure of the purpose of this particular village survey or what the results will be used for. It is likely that the survey may have been edited with questions either added or deleted so are unsure what questions you may be asked. TO CLARIFY MATTERS THE PARISH COUNCIL WILL PUT NOTICES IN THE NOTICEBOARD AND IN WHATS-ON BEFORE CONTACTING PEOPLE WITH ANY SURVEY. WE CURRENTLY HAVE NO SUCH SURVEY THAT WE ARE PLANNING ON SENDING TO RESIDENTS.

COLD CALLING IN THE PARISH

Please be aware that there has been some cold calling in the Parish with regard to the above survey. There are areas in the Parish which are no cold calling areas. If you are bothered by 'cold callers' please be reminded that you do not need to open the door to them and you can also call 101 to report any inappropriate cold calling.

DOG WALKERS

There are a few however who are just walking their dogs wherever they like, through whichever fields they like, even where there are no footpaths. This is inappropriate and a landowner does have the right to shoot your dog in such circumstances. Please also be aware that it has become apparent that someone is walking their dogs in a determined manner armed with bolt cutters to get through fences. If anyone sees this please report it to the dog wardens at the District Council. This is endangering the enclosed livestock and financially damaging in terms of repair work, vets bills for the farmers. As always please walk your dogs responsibly and stick to paths and everyone then keeps safe as there has been another incident of a sheep mauled to death by an out of control dog.

THE BATCH






