

MILES & HURMAN TRUST CHARITY FARM UPDATE

You may remember the Trustees applied for Outline Planning Consent for 25 dwellings on the Charity Farm Site in April 2019, this application has now been approved in principle by Sedgemoor District Council, the next stage is getting the Legal details settled before receiving final approval.

The Trustees have been using the time since April in contact with various Developers, trying to negotiate an arrangement which fulfils the ambition of the Ashcott Neighbourhood Plan, whereby the Trust becomes the owner of the Affordable Housing on the Site. Unfortunately it has not been possible to achieve this, so the Trustees have had to look at a different approach.

The Trustees priority has always been the provision of Affordable Housing for local people.

Sedgemoor District Council have conducted a new Housing Needs Survey, which now shows a requirement of 10 Affordable Houses to rent by people with local connections, seeking accommodation in the Village.

The Trustees engaged an Agent to find a way of delivering this requirement, and we have now received an offer from Live West, a Housing Association. Live West propose to build a total of 25 Affordable Homes. 17 of which will be available for rent by local people, the remaining 8 will be available for local people to buy on a Shared Ownership basis. Live West would buy the Site from the Trust and would own all the Affordable Houses.

Local people would be given top priority when the homes are built, this will be part of the Planning Consent Legal Agreement (S106), with Sedgemoor District Council.

The Trust would receive a substantial sum from the sale of the Site, and are required by the Charity Commission to invest this money to provide an income, which will be used to benefit the Village.

The Trustees are very conscious this new proposal is quite different from that previously discussed with the Village, and so have already consulted with the Parish Council, who have given this scheme their support.

The Trustees have arranged an open "Village Consultation" to enable more information about the scheme to be made available to Villagers. Live West will attend.





Church News

Hi folks,

When should a vicar speak out about politics — and in particular about Brexit? That's a question that's been exercising my mind a fair bit lately, and was the subject of our discussion at Café Church earlier this month.

In the turbulent events of the last few weeks, I realised that there was one issue that I should speak about — which is the rule of law. Meanwhile, the Bishops of the Church of England made a joint statement which expressed the point succinctly. In it, they said, "We call on politicians to adhere rigorously to the rule of law and on all to respect and uphold the impartiality of the courts and our judiciary."

The Bishops' statement also highlighted the dangers of descending into abuse and division. The whole Brexit debate and process has very divisive. Part of the calling of the church is to be peacemakers. As Jesus said, "Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God." I'm therefore including a Church of England prayer for the nation at this time.


