
Church News

Hi folks,

So, what's up with the flimsy paper? Bit tight on the church finances are we?

Over the last year, climate change has become even bigger news than it was before. Part of this is because of the protest

group Extinction Rebellion and the Swedish teenage climate activist Greta Thunberg, who have both frequently attracted headlines but this is part of a growing awareness that climate change really is happening, and that we each have responsibility to ensure



that it doesn't get out of control. Global warming is one of the most obvious aspects of climate change — illustrated in the graphic.

Churches have not often been at the forefront of the environmental movement. This is odd if we really believe that the Earth is God's creation — should we not act as if we actually value what God has created?

As a group of churches, we in the Polden Wheel realise that we have a part to play as well. In some ways it's an uphill task: mediaeval stone churches weren't built with either insulation or double-glazing in mind. But there are things that we can do — such as making sure we use eco-friendly light-bulbs, and looking at our electricity suppliers and heating sources. It's important that we do what we can do. And much as I like the look and feel of the thicker 100gsm paper, recycled paper is more environmentally responsible.

Meanwhile... may I wish you all a Happy New Year!
